Canada is currently looking for truckers to fill an important demand. Successful applicants must have the financial capacity to take the complementary courses in Québec and have the necessary funds to live in Canada during the process of obtaining their Canadian trucker's permit.

Please read the following information before completing form :

- The candidate must be at least 25 years of age and have 5 years experience as a truck driver
- Candidates must be trained at a school recognized for their Canadian driver's license, and must have a financial autonomy of approximately \$ 7,000 Cda.
- The candidate must make a deposit of \$ 600 Cda for the evaluation of his file. A positive record will allow us to get your employment contract.

Upon request we will e-mail you an invoice to settle your case study according to one of the payment methods, along with an admission form.

Documents to provide for evaluation of your request including MANDATORY work experience

- Record of conduct or civil status file where available
- Copy of your driver's license

Deadline :

Within 48 hours of the reception of your payment and documents, you will be invited to your online interview during which your acceptance reply will be confirmed and the terms will be sent to you by e-mail.

The 3,750 \$ course package includes :

(\$ 3,750 is the maximum cost for the complementary course, an assessment will allow us to identify the individual needs of each trucker and give them the precise cost according to their skills. For example: truckers who have already driven american trucks, or those who have already driven trucks in the USA or Canada, will need fewer hours of training, and therefore the cost of the course will be less)

- Transportation upon arrival to Montreal Trudeau airport to the location where the course will be given and / or place of residence. We can provide you residential addresses near your workplace or course location.
- The 104-hour 4-week course - Course information given to qualified candidates
- A guaranteed two-year employment contract, the candidate will have his contract of employment and proof of registration to the course, before payment of the course.
- A 2 year working permit.
- Access to Québec health insurance during the hiring period

Timetable

- Applicant's request for study and options
- Provide all the documents required to search for a work contract and pre-registration to the complementary driving course at a school recognized by the Société de l'Assurance Automobile du Québec(SAAQ)
- Within 10 days of your acceptance by a transportation company, you will receive your employment contract and proof of registration at the course.

- The candidate will have to transfer the funds necessary to confirm his registration to the course so that the transport company files his visa application to the Canadian government (response time of the government authorities is approximately 6 to 8 weeks). The candidate will receive a letter of introduction from the Canadian government to collect his visa from the Canadian Embassy in his country.
- You will then need to obtain your airline ticket and notify us of your date of arrival in Canada.
- In less than 3 months after your application you should be able to travel to Canada and have the documents in hand to receive your work permit when arriving at Montreal Trudeau airport.
- Upon his arrival, we will make the candidate's appointment to pick up his Class 5 or Class 1 theoretical exam. . . 30 days later, the truck driver will be able to pick up his Class 1 license, which will enable him to start working.
